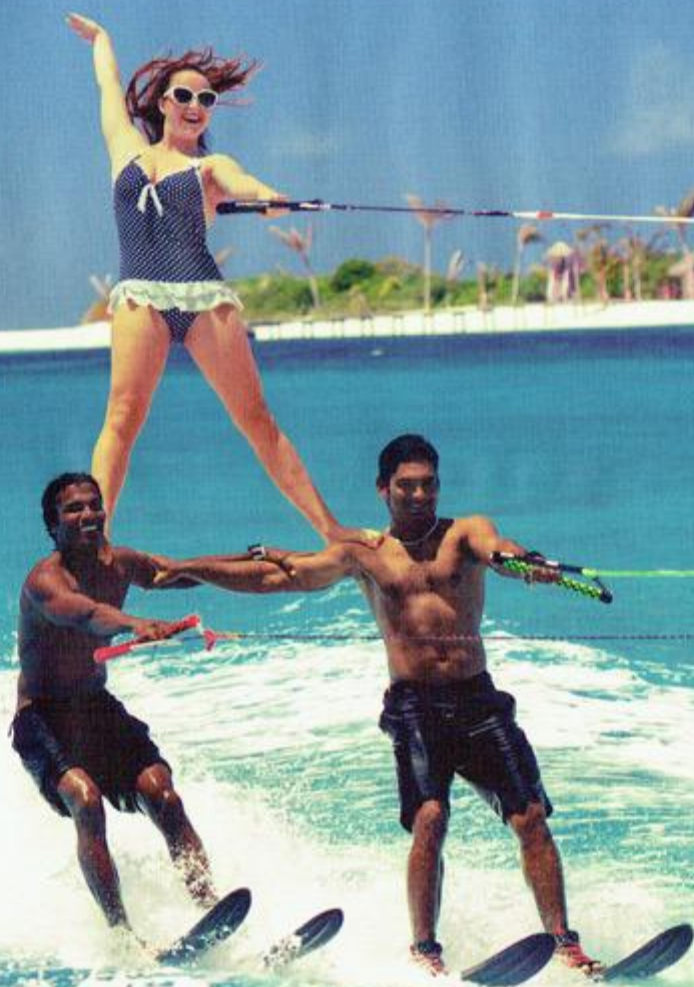

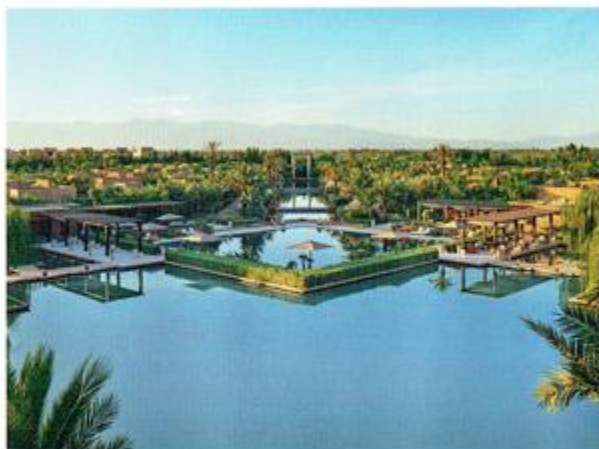

Yeeeeessss! Hurrah for the Mandarin Oriental Marrakech: 54 villas and nine suites of perfection only 10 minutes away from North Africa's most romantic city. This is huge: most hotels outside of the city walls are miles away pretending they are not, whereas Mandarin Oriental is the real deal. There's nothing not to love about 20 acres' worth of 100,000 scented roses, drifts of jasmine and serene pools of water, all set against the backdrop of the Atlas Mountains. Cambodia promises new adventure beyond the Wats and Siem Reap. Six Senses Krabey Island opens next year and ticks every modern mindful box: a meditation cave, "sleep ambassadors" to advise on the best rest, detox, yoga, a juice bar, a nail bar, and cookery classes at Indochine, the restaurant with the on-trend see-through kitchen. Top it off with 40 pool villas and, best of all, a poolside outdoor Cinema Paradiso. Indian Summer

Colonial Indian once meant Lutylens, chhota pegs and cigars. Krithika Subrahmanian has reinvented the wheel at her family property Svatma in Tanjore, a secret destination in the south accessed from Chennai (BA has direct flights). Chanting: tick. Meditative gym and yoga: tick. Traditional asanas: tick. Organic vegetarian food: tick—but with comfort food like mac 'n' cheese: double tick. This is an alternative India, mindfully healthy, where the chef can explain everything from his compost (possibly too much info) to his ethnic ingredients, none of which comes from a bottle. AYURVEDIC RETREAT

While you're in India: Hampi is a wonder. A fantasy of temples, elephant stables, statues, aqueducts and canals, it was once the capital of the Vijayanagara Empire and, in around 1500, the second-largest city in the world after Beijing. It has to be seen, but there was Nowhere To Stay until now. The Orange County Hampi, designed as a Vijayanagara palace and fort, opened this year with 45 large rooms, each with a private pool or Jacuzzi. The cracking Ayurvedic Spa is inspired by Hampi's centuries-old Lotus Mahal. audleytravel.com
